13th Smith's Cemetery Planted May the 12th 1866

James Cameron of Island 23rd of May 1866
finished Planting potatoes Before the door

Went to Williamstown with 2 Sturgeon 2 Bottles of syrup ready Sunday the 24th Morning Blowing 25" got home the sheep sheared 3 of Mary 1 for framing Sturgeon for Ellen and Bottle of syrup for Ellen the Sheep Fishing at night slept all night on the Little Island above cakes for her children currants Mr Harper offered to help great chopping on Chusters Island 26th Sheared the rest of the sheep. Price aster these Days 13" I came from Williamsburg fishing tonight seen Henry Genie fishing Marked numerous sheep cut. Good fish Broth will get 14 oz of Herring Soap tails of all the Rainies and packed them 27th Went to Mr Harpers lot pieces for a Gallt from William Stott at Mr Hay Lancaster Bought 1/2 bushel of Potatoes 1/3 1/3 pt of Butter 1/2 bushel of Buckwheat Bought a Bottle of Ink 1/2 lb Bought of Baker & Son Bought of Mr Nicholson the Baker 5 Loaves of Bread 3/8 returned of Bread 2/10 Came home after at the Lighthouse John Grasher bottle took dinner at Mr Harpers packed home took dinner or a snack in my canoe wind high tried growing got no bites 28th Planted Potatoes and Beans The Express Train ran of the track ice going down at the Back garden gone down the Reg Pen Planted cucumbers High Wind and Rain the Sun hatching in the Goose Stable Phantoms Melons 1/4 2/3 Bushels Musk C. hills of water below 22 hills of cucumbers Some Potato onions in the garden yesterday nothing on the ground yet Rafts went down High water and America going a curious kind Got a Cow Bell in Williamstown Ploughed at the door 15th Steamer Towed up by the Highlander 23 Royal Oak Sowed 1/2 of Wheat Planted some Potatoes at the Bay 30th Went to Lancaster with Mr Harpers Pot and 13 lbs of sugar for of the Wheat set fire on the North side of the fish Bay for the Pot to 2 Bushels of oats 17 into a Bushel to 2 Bushels in the marsh the British America came down a Potato 2/6 2 lb. 8 oz a 1/10 oz with Little Tim Mr Dougall fishing. Slept at the lower end of the Butternut Island. Sod on his Mother's grave Guizwales and Tim Mr Dougall went the Spartan and Kingston going down together with their horses to Ross Island High West Wind Sat 16th Planted some Spinach and Turnips amongst the potato Henry in Lancaster slept above Allen Mays in the Bay Gordon and I looking for fine fished the gap in the fence east. Slept all night at Allen Mays seen Allen Harten stuck and made some Hails The Salaberry came in from the 8th Conception 31st Whit Sunday Last Day of May I Salmon River the first time got aground The Salmon came up alone side shore from Allen Mays slept at Henry's had tried to take her off but could not. Fogg the stormy Bora left Lewis Boxall at home the Salaberry went down. The Osprey went down East Elgin went down. Thunder wind high some cold rain seen young Jucks 1st of Cannons roaring took down the slate of the old house 17 June Planted a few hills of Potatoes Sashay here Washing the Wool Sunday America trying to take the Salaberry of 18th Working at the very cold. 2nd Scraps Wrote a letter to Mr J. Lynch Montreal also Fence 18th at the fence 20th Went to Summers Bay Wilkhaballey Square old Bottell Departed sent 2 papers to Christie Sgt. The Salaberry got off got on again the America took him took the wool to Thomas Munroe 13 lbs then Pat not take her off Mrs. Munroe went to Cornwall Bright taking down hay and wool for Mr Harper to Lancaster Andrew Bottles of Maple Syrup to her 21st Ascension Day & July 1st August Munroe sent the postage for the letter and paper as I forgot to do so paid to D Baker 1/2 Bushel of Potatoes took dinner at him in my pocket Book Went down to Bottell Slept at Ross' 1st of August with a bottle of Milk Bottles left at the door took tea all night at Bottell 3rd took Breakfast there and in the morning Rained a great deal in the afternoon put the wool in the bag tried growing got none
