- 1 Monday. Pa left for California Springs this morning. Murdy went to Cornwall Jimmie had before 1/2 day put in loads of hay
- 2 Drizzle of rain all day. Jimmie mowing
- 3 Wet all forenoon boys went to Cornwall to play lacrosse (a practice).
- 4 Boys did not get home until 2 A.M. Part of the Stornont cotton mill was burnt last night. Got B strap 25 25-  
Gust 10. 2 lb B sugar 10. H. & M. S. 25 45-
- 5 Jimmie Bella & Duncan D.D. came last evening. Boys finished the hay. Whitford put in a load here of ugly green stuff  
Got 2 cans salmon 30. 2 lb raisins 15 45-  
Gave Murdy 40 cts to shoe Brown's horse 40
- 6 All the boys went to Montreal this morning at 6. Got 6 lbs steak 60 Cream Laska 10 70.  
There was quite a storm of wind & rain at noon but it cleared up nicely at 4 P.M. and the ship M G's left for home
- 7 Fine day. I did not go to church
- 8 Fine day. Mrs J. A. Mc Donnell and myself finished packing boxes for N. H.
- 9 Began raining last night and was showery today
- 10 Fine day. Murdy went to Cornwall I sent the bale to Lancaster by Snider Got 8. 7 cheese from factory this morning Had to bring all the horses home last night. They were getting into the buck wheat field. The express on the bale 30 cts charged to the H. F. M. S. It began to storm and rain between 3 and 4. The rain
