 3 Tons Fine Day 14<sup>th</sup> St. Valentine's Day Fine & Wind  
 Cold crust icicles first time to crop with the Horse  
 Randolph went for the Mail Bought of Mr Powell  
 50 Wt of Flour for 50 gave 2 Dollars 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> Fine  
 but Rave the wind Drifting 16<sup>th</sup> Fine Warm Drifting  
 Snowing & Wind high Hauling Working at shafts  
 for the Sleigh Left the Ferry out to night put  
 2 of the Calves in her place 17<sup>th</sup> Throve Sicesday  
 West Wind Drifting Snowing stormy working at the  
 shafts 18<sup>th</sup> James Hough's Birth Day (Wh. W. 1885)  
 Mr J. M. Dougall came with the Bull Took my  
 Ashes 35 Bushels for 15 paid him 75 cents for the 3 loads  
 Told me Campbell the Weaver was found Froze last  
 Week and 3 or 4 of the Carries Departed with Drift  
 Randolph cropped with Sell Dougall

 a hundred weight of Flour at 2:15 & 1/2 a pair of Boots  
 for Alexander 2 Dollars (Bought a Jacket 15 paid this  
 pair of small shoes 30 cents paid this) Bought of Mr  
 Ward a pair of Boots on Credit 1:25 Settled with  
 him gave him a hide 80 lb at 5 cents 4 Dollars Flour  
 Boots Lock Bit that is a Balance coming to  
 me 1:15 only got the Boots on this to Day which will  
 save coming to me 50 cents 27<sup>th</sup> Fine Day putting  
 manure on the Lower Point seen 2 Elk Fishers  
 over at Christies had a horse and Cutter  
 Randolph cropped to P.O. Bought of  
 John Sumners 1 Dg of Herrings 20 paid this  
 got a Bag of oats and heads from  
 H. Amittens 28<sup>th</sup> Fine Day putting stones  
 on the wharf from the old churchny  
 at of Newch St. W. W. Day The Festival of the  
 Welsh Raining snowing left 2<sup>nd</sup> went to P.P. on  
 cutting Basswoods on the Bank snowing blowing  
 cutting Stone Wood Races on the ice  
 Clearing the ice Races on the ice at Jo Dougall's
