SATURDAY 23

327-38)

It was a nice day I ploughed Abbie was here for dinner

24 It was a nice day the boys and I went up to Sunday school and preaching. Ada and Robert went to church in the evening 1918 it was frozen quite a little we put in the straw Mr. Lammie helped us Billy cottage the children went over to Mr. Lammie
