 1 Bottle of cod Liver oil with a penny  
 paid 3 cents on the Letter 7<sup>th</sup> Cold Frosty  
 a cutter cropped up the ice to Hamilton  
 from the South Side cleaning the pipes  
 W Wind 7<sup>th</sup> Frosty to night 8<sup>th</sup> Bismarck  
 cropped to Summerstown Bought of

 in snow took a Barrel out of the shed to put  
 the hay on churning to day not very well  
 18<sup>th</sup> W Wind cold and frosty Frosty Drifting
