- 5 Got 2 pans of bread 48. 1 lb. G tea 7 lb B tea some hard, 15 yesterday. Marion baked some pies. Jimmie took Mary & Marion to the Island yesterday. he got two dove 1 perch from a man  
7/8 2 1/2 lb sausage 25. Muddy took birds on a creek whose outlet is in our creek
- 6 Very heavy rain. Not many in church  
Muddy went to Apple Hill
- 7 Fine day. There was a down struck by lightning on the Branch yesterday and burned  
Muddy came home in evening and brought Birdie and Peter
- 8 7/8 2 lb sausage 20. Marion came home  
Jimmie went for her. To 4 loaves 24
- 9 Jimmie drove Birdie home. Muddy came. The other engineer got sick. They had to stop the work. Hot Hot
- 10 Very hot. Marion to dinner at Robertsons
- 11 Still hot. Looks like rain. Muddy left for space
- 12 A pretty large congregation. Rain in afternoon
- 13 Muddy got home in evening. I had a call from Miss Macklock. I made the washing. Ann Hall could not come. Began to rain

- 15 Rained and stormed in night. rained all day. 7/8 1 galf. coal oil 20
- 16 Bright and high wind. 7/8 beef 25  
Marion went to Lancaster with The Robertson girls to see Mrs. McShonell to the train
- 17 Mrs Robertson and William Mc Kee of N.Y. called. Jimmie & Marion went to H Island Very fine day. Muddy away
- 18 Fine day
- 19 7/8 pork 45. Muddy left for parts unknown  
Jimmie went to Cornwall
- 20 Rain last night. Not many in church  
Jim & Marion drove to the Branch. Bird not at home. Birdie, John & babies came about 9 P.M.
- 21 Had Ann Hall 1/2 day 25. Marion went off in evening to remain all night in Cornwall
- 22 John Smith came yesterday afternoon to work at the verandah. Tom Colett paid \$2.00 for cow pasture. Sold 4 doz eggs. 64 7/8 pail hard hats - rum 5. yeast 5. soap 10. Spool 7.5. pepper ment  
Cereus in Cornwall. Getting one paint & oil at Wallis
- 23 7/8 mutton \$1.10
- 24 Muddy got home at 9 P.M. yesterday John came for Birdie and babies
- 25 Smith 1/2 day. we did not get the lumber
- 26 I am not so well as usual. 7/8 4 lb sausage 40. 50 of flour yesterday  
1/2 lb B tea tick McCremon paid 86<sup>00</sup>  
for ground rent  
Got at Lancaster rooled wheat \$1.00
