- 1 1/2 yds table linen 45^{cts} 15 3 pair socks 55^{cts} 190
- 2 pair socks. 15-30-1 pair long hose 15-1 paper pins 50
- 8 yds lace 25^{cts}. Far come home, but went off again to go to Fort Covington tomorrow, which is the 4th July. The examination of candidates for 2d & 3rd. Class certificates, began today
- 4. I go with my number to prayer meeting. Far went to Fort Covington to see the gunnery salute the day
- 5. Women's Meeting at W. Campbell's 16 present. Besides the women of the house I gave 50. and 10 for a special collection to enable the society to defray the running expenses 60

- 7 sold W. Jordan 1 bush potatoes 30^{cts} paid Dixon 2^{cts} for putting some teeth in mowing machine. Boys but Run. went to a pie pie on S. Branch and to Cornwall to see a game of Lacrosse between Shamocks and Cornwall's, which did not come off. Pa was on the war path today
