Sat. 5. I swept the dining room & mended it. Made two pie present pie & small cakes & a custard pie for supper. Will & Paul gone to Welland I churned the first thing in the morning Marjorie washed the front room windows. swept the front room & kitchen. the children guarded the cows in forenoon & went to Harvey Wells after dinner & got her sweeping money. when she went after the cows I cleaned up the boards swept the yard up & got Paul's supper Arthur took in the forenoon afternoon went to Chippawa to get

Net - shod took 1 doz & 4 eggs got granulated sugar & 2 5-d beefs 22 yearags today our dear Bert died on Sunday that day for Sun 6 Grand day wind north. Marjorie died on Sunday that day for but greivous from the other house he has gone to Welland with Tom one in church Marjorie wore her new shoes Paul brought Ten Hattie rode to the brick with Mr Russ & his adopted sister

Hattie came over in the evening & gave the children their ^{small} ^{last} I mended the duck pen all out for the east side & cool Will & Arthur I cleaned the duck pen all out for the east side & cool Will & Arthur at their potato ground. Paul in Doubby Wells Marjorie went to the threaded wheat works got a hundred. had 2 1/2

Butter 2 1/2 - 40 - 10 eggs 15 - B. Dunsin 25 - screen 23 I sent Paul to Mc Greder's today he fell sick all day & Will had the cow up there he got there. I churned yesterday & today I cleaned the hen house out shed the hens in the pickled part while I cleaned it. I had the hens in the I put it on the ground by the barn & was tired at night.

Wed 9. Marjorie went to Mrs Mc Greder's to help her get ready for the bee. Mrs Reisinger for tea I made a sponge cake for supper I had everything to do after she went away Hattie came over & stayed all night for Paul stayed away he was in traps for two days or parts of two I churned & worked the butter

Thurs 10 ranning such a nice gentle shower doing so much good Arthur came over I said let the hens out - been shut up over two weeks I partly mended Paul's drawer they are a job on mistake, cleared up in the afternoon Arthur away on the cart - about the road grader. Will big cow & the black one each had a calf Paul came home at night

Friday 11. I baked bread, washed the ting full of clothes boiled for they were white clothes. Marjorie's bees swarmed. I was just about overheated. Mc Greder's dog Hattie went up. Marjorie brought word that Ida was done with her suffering died last night. Paul went to Chippawa in the afternoon, with Tom Mc Greder man drawing cement. Will ~~harvey~~ collected

the potato patch & the oats he was rolling all day. Hattie came after Marjorie. Hattie & Paul are going to self. Expense. Will. Arthur & Paul are going to Chippawa to go to Clayton

Sat 12. Hattie took Marjorie to Chippawa. Butter came 1 3/4 doz took 7 3/4 butter 2 lb 7 one doz eggs 18. coffee 13. baking soda coal oil 18. matches 4. salt 10. yeast 5. coffee 13. baking soda

10. pumpkin 10 ginger 5 candy 5 tea 30 sugar 25 cheese 15 I churned for our selves made 8 pumpkin pies blackcurrant - sent 6 of them & small sponge cake. washed a lot of calicoes

I finished Paul's drawer. we got 25 lb of meal only 2 3/4 The youngsters stayed alone Hattie stayed with her mother they got home from Quelf about 12
