Fine sunny day cooler windy. W. Rea up all day paid him on fuel 12.00. We finished hoeing turnips and time spent out plowing No 7 J.L. Aunt Aggie here for dinner at home for tea. Mary drove her to station for Melba got lions 25 groceries 30 at foot.
