14. Cheone up the flour & put in the Chaff. we cleaned up the six bags of Redfurn wheat for the mill.
15. I took care of the Cattle and split wood
16. very stormy day high wind in snow with drift could not get about the Cows, there much high winds
17. Rev. Mr. Ferguson preached in the Methodist Church in the morning Mr. Wright in ours at night
