Dallan am scraped up the dung there being rain  
lost night I intend to go to Hamilton on the Express

19 am & dd drew down at the road fine day

20 they worked at the dung, very dry

21 am helped Henry Webster to troughs Ad drawn

22 do do do I went for Besse to

manager in the afternoon I got home from Hamilton  
by the Express all well had a fine time & fine  
show every thing good except feed roots  
they were poor & fine of them I stayed in town  
at Frank's stalls all night they are all well

23 am is out to the road I am seeing things at home

24 Rev W. Stewart preaches this morning no meeting at me

25 dd & am drew dung to the south east corner of the road  
field I went with S. Marchant to see about cutting  
the Rev W. Caswell

rain 26 began to rain about 3 o'clock this morning (rain)  
most of the day (broke) peas & gathered the dung  
in the sheep pen Billie came from  
Lynn, Saund on the Express

27 Billie & me went to evening Betsey is  
no better I stayed at Nevequels all night

drew out dd & am dug potatoes at the Bona power

28 Billie & me went to Delta Fair good 20 p.

got 29 rain most of the night & most of the day  
I got home at night all well the Rev  
W. Russell came on the Express

30 dug potatoes I filled part of a gate
