 very fine today
 21 Boys drew dung I helped I Bears thrash
 for Benj^r W. very fine & clear
 22 Boys finished drawing dung on field
 behind barn then ganged spring wheat
 stubble a.m. they helped Elias draw
 last of his harvest then they ganged
 east of creek below Orchard W. fine
 cool towards evening
 Sunday 23 at home Glavin's & family were
 here all P.M. I & Henry walked to Pt C after
 supper W. very fine & clear day
 24 a & Henry single plowed in fall wheat
 stubble I went to Markham P.M. I went to
 Whitewater P.M. W. fine clear cool
 25 Boys finished plowing wheat stubble Henry
 & Sarah went to Mary Burkholder's late

come at Mongolia some of her personal
 property was divided. P.M. I & Henry and
 Susanna went to Elias's then to Does
 to Jennie Stowers to dinner W. very fine
 some light frosts the last few days
 26 Boys dug some drain in Knoll Henry
 brought 500 2 1/2 in tiles W. very fine clear
 I took Susanna to Flevie this morning
 she stays all night
 27 Henry went to Merro Burkholder's farm
 & drew dung (they intend to move on it in the
 spring) a helped Benj^r thrash all day I
 worked at the drain W. very fine & clear Esther
 & her hired girl were here helping us clean our
 rooms & took up the Carpet & put it down again
 28 a helped Henry draw dung I grubbed
 the wheat ground I went to Cedar Grove
 a.m. I & Henry went to Elias's P.M. the
 children are still coughing W. very fine
 29 a helped Elias thrash till after 3 P.M.
 I & Henry drew home some wood Henry went
 to H Bishop's Dale in Borgrove W. fine
 Monday 30 all went to meeting at Hebron except
 I & Susanna remarks by C
 Burkholder sermon on Mt Mat 18 & by the
 layman Hermon's were here a while P.M.
 Ed Meyers were here to supply W. very warm
 Por N was thrown out of his buggy yesterday
 he laid insensible about 10 minutes they
 took him home
