PM he plowed corn land 4 horses I cleaned out pig pen cleaned up barn floor fixed fence etc. We got letter from Stephen Shipman Inc St Marie enclosing cheque for \$40.00 payment on St Joe lots

Willie went to Guelph to see plowing match at O.A.E. expenses 65 cts I plowed in No 5 sod and fowed out in No 4 14 94 buckwheat land AM with team also took turnip box and rack over to other barn. PM I plowed corn stubble No 6. 4 horses. Willie paid Geo Douglas \$1.00 yesterday helping with corn.
