- Sun Dec 30th cloudy and soft commenced to rain about two o'clock the snow going fast
- Mon Dec 31st cloudy and soft a heavy rain last night. the snow all gone, plenty of mud
- Tue January 1 1907 cloudy and soft. Sarah was in a few minutes and Thomas Bolton his wife was here an over an two
- Wed Jan 2 cloudy Bilton was here this fore noon Sarah was over for the dirty clothes

- Fri Jan 4th clear later part of the day. Sarah was here cleaning the house. Bilton was here in the fore noon. Ella Snary was here collecting money for missoraries.
- Sat Jan 5th clear and warm like an April day. I had Walter in for the key early this morning and then James Young John Tiffin and Bilton a few minutes
- Sun Jan 6 a foggy day. Sarah McIntosh was in a few minutes this evening
- Mon Jan 7th cloudy and thunder showers in the after noon. Sarah came in this after noon. this day they putting in the town ship officers I didn't go over
- Tue Jan 8th cloudy a heavy thunder and lightning showers last night. Sarah, Walter and James Safertree was in a few minutes
- Wed Jan 9th cloudy and cold Bilton was here I sent away for the New York Witness
