- Sat Feb 8. Very, very cold. Aunt Mattie walked home in the morning. Uncle took me out in the afternoon I went to the Pink and remained at Mother's. this sideroad fairly good but the others dreadful.
- Sun Feb 9. Fine bright day a little milder. I went up to Church. Uncle and Aunt Nellie there. I went to Fisherville in the afternoon.
