- 24 Fine day Jimmie & Murdy went to Alex Donalds to bid farewell to Lord Donald. He is to be at the Presbyterian Church, will lunch with J. McDonald Greenfield
- 25 The boys put in four big loads of hay at home, they finished on the Village farm. Pa had Louis shingling the R. of Kentail house. Got 1500 shingles from McArthurson. 4.10 I made a pretty large washing left the white clothes in water I used 5 sheets of Murdy's, not starched,
- 26 Rain, did not put-out washing Jimmie away all day
- 27 Fine day, To bread 20, Pa paid Corn 86.00 Sold 5 3/4 doz eggs @ 92, To 1 lb Tea 40 1 paper 25

- 28 Rain drizzle
- 29 Mrs Archie McArthur Lancaster was buried here today. John Robertson N. B & Ferguson bore, took tea with us.
- 30 Fine day Jimmie fixed floors of barn & Con To 3 lbs steak 30 charge
- 31 Rain not many in church, Mrs Rogers (Maggie Talbot) sang a solo. "When I shall see Him face to face" It was very fine.

August 1904

- 1 Fine day, Jimmie cut some hay on Le Con Kenneth
- 2 Jimmie put up about two loads of hay
- 3 Kenneth from Durwegan and Mary McLennan from Scotland here all night-left today J. J. Pic etc to Hamiltons Island. Only Murdy from here
- 4 Fine day. Jimmie has men working at hay. D. M. Rysman & team J. K. Mc El with one horse & young pigged W. Muting at Kate Dairys walls. Mrs Tom there, Margie Govin has cramps and is afraid of apendicitis. I washed 3 sheets & 4 blankets
- 5 Fine day, Jimmie is off to the hay Murdy is out back did not turn up since the pie pie Evening. Jimmie is through with the hay, on buck farm, Making, lost 7.81 Put in 12 loads. Salway, made some on share our share 6 loads, Tom Hunan made some
- 6 To beef 45^{cts} Fine day 45
- 7 Fine day looks like rain, fine large congregation
- 8 Dry day fixing my silk skirt
- 9 Sold 3 3/4 doz eggs 1 gull and oil 20. 4 1/2 yds 20
 brush board 5^{cts} 23^{cts} 23
- 10 To 3 lbs steak charged at McDulys 30
 To 4 loaves bread tick, 3/4 yd paper for flower pot 10^{cts} Darry McDonald married today in church. I was there, and Jimmie and Murdy, Pindie and her men My present was Mrs Kopus Cook book 92. 2. - 10
- 11 Cloudy, a heavy shower in fore noon Layon social tonight at Mansie, my contribution 55
 1 lb tea 25^{cts} 3 lbs steak charged 40
 bread, paid the other loaves 4^{cts}
