Mon Sept 5th clear most of the day and hot, cloudy this evening. had my thrashing done to day finished about half past two had 26 bushels of rye 46 of wheat ~~470~~ 470 of oats

Tue Sept 6th cloudy and thunder showers. I was cutting up corn when it was dry, and piling up the rails that was under the stacks. Walter was plowing

Wed Sept 7th clear and pretty high wind. I was cutting up corn until 3 P.M. the ~~wind~~ wind got so high I had to quit. Walter was plowing

Thu Sept 8th clear and pleasant quite cool this morning. I ditching along the line between William Law and me. Walter finished plowing the little field West of the new orchard.

Fri Sept 9th cloudy and wet most of the day we were cleaning up seed wheat in the fore noon after noon working on the ditch till rain came

Sat Sept 10th clear and pleasant. I was ditching. Walter finished cutting up corn.

Sun Sept 11th clear part of the day and cool. cloudy in the evening

Mon Sept 12th cloudy in the evening fore part of the day clear and hot. I was husking corn. Walter was harrowing the ground for drilling.

Tue Sept 13th clear and very hot. Walter finished the little field below the new Orchard with wheat. I was husking and carrying in corn.

Wed Sept 14th clear part of the day cool in the morning hot in the middle of the day. I was husking corn. Walter was harrowing.

Thu Sept 15th cloudy part of the day little mist of rain once or ~~twice~~ twice. we finished sowing wheat. I was husking part of the day.
