- 1 The Revd Mr W Gillroy came on the Express this morning & preached this morning here & at Fairfax in the afternoon
- 2 Sifted grass seed fine day they loaded 13 barrels of seed
- 3 Ad went to Mr Cready's Mill & brought home a load of scuffling for forcing with the waggon hard frost
- 4 Ad sowed a bushel & half of timothy & half a bushel of clover seed in the north field where the hay was
- 5 I went gathered 12 bushels of seed they loaded it down <sup>last fall</sup>
- 6 Ad went to Mr Cready's saw mill for some stuff fine day down the load to the side of the center of the first field because <sup>the</sup> hard frost last night North wind Ad went to Mr Cready's Mill for a load of fence stuff took the stuff to the center of the field between the house Mr W Gillroy and Revd Mr Stewart preacher this morning & Mr W Gillroy <sup>on the Express</sup> at night
- 9 Ad got his finger laid open on Saturday in a way by Dr Atkinson it is better
- 10 I went to Belleville on the Express to attend a meeting of the Presbytery there was a very large number of Ministers & Elders in attendance we went to the church at once got supper with the lecture & <sup>and</sup> set till after twelve o'clock
- 11 Ad began to saw & sawed <sup>some</sup> bushel of oats at home a cold dry time
- 12 I got home on the Express this morning all well Ad is dragging & sawing oats at the road
- 13 I fixed the fences at the first ditch & let the sheep out of the pen there is frost every night
- 14 I fixed up the gate at the arbor & had up some pieces fine worm day Mr W Gillroy came on the Express
- 15 Revd Mr W Gillroy preached this morning Mr Trumble at
- 16 Mr W Gillroy went to Kingston this morning Ad cleaned <sup>up</sup> 4 bags of oats he is sawing & dragging at the road Mr Walker stopped on his way to Guilford over night
- 17 Mr Walker went away on the Express this morning I took care of the Cattle & went out to the road for some of my tools that was out there
