had in when the engine John helped in cut: paid 7.00 & 8.75

Sun 12. Arthur & Hattie went around by Harvey & took Miss Andrew
in the brick church quite cold east wind Margaret went in Elphinstone
in stay 2 weeks Paul took her in Francis Hattie & Ann over in
the evening.

Mon 13 rained nearly all day Paul let the gander out & he
enjoyed it for he has been shut up since he 9 of November
I churned in the forenoon & boiled the mince meat & chopped
the suet after dinner swept the front room peeled the apples
& chopped them & the mince meat got up at five o'clock &
blackened the stove & made the fire had breakfast & sent
the teacher at Wells they went down in practice ^{not come} Tom & Hattie did
Tues 14 got up at 5 o'clock vacuum of the bread blackened
the stove through breakfast 20 & 7. bread mixed before 8
real cold. wind changed in the night blew terrible on the night
had to get up every half while in that the door the front door
was something awful Reel would lay there if everything in the
room blew out made pies apple pies & blackcurrant tarts
& white cookies after Paul went down in practice I washed
cleaned the floor dusted the front room. & cleaned up the pantry

Wed 15 cold & cloudy the front room dark. I got up at 5 o'clock
made two fires. swept & dusted. Paul walked in Elphinstone
got a 81 on 7 di groceries. raisins 25 currants 25 & sugar 25
cinnamon 10 & allspice 5 candied peel 10 soap 5 nutmegs 2
Mrs McCreedy here for dinner. Lily over after dinner I went part way
with her but cold west wind.

Thurs 16 cold yet west wind I dressed two roosters in sand with
Inagie at night. I burned Reel's hat for the entertainment. Annie
came home from Sharps. Tom McCreedy called on for Richard Paul
Friday 17. real cold & snowing hard at times high west wind.
Entertainment tonight made 918. Ellen Hexum's wife came in
with her baby. Reavley over & gave a number of selections.

Sat 18 churned yesterday for our selves cleaned the floor
made two apple pies & black currant tarts they took the organ
& lamps in the church & put the seats back & Margaret swept & dusted
Sun 19 bitter cold west wind the children went in church
Gordon went back in Kueingers in lake money for the preacher
he got his dinner at Wells Mary & her mother over for tea
Arthur up in Harvey Hall for tea the girls came over
to say goodbye they are going in Holland on Thursday
in stay in Sharps until Thursday (Mon 20) made a big ^{cake} ^{fish}

Mon 20 I churned & worked the butter & fried a lot
of apples. very cold yet wind west I set things tonight
Tues 21 snowed in the night enough to make it cold
on the feet. Arthur going in Elphinstone with his horses
Paul went with him & took 3 turkey hens one for Kueingers
weighed 12 1/2 & 17 1/2 two in Elmerfeld one 11 1/2 one 12 1/2 ^{they came}
Paul carried a box of turkey & I weighed them on the ^{boat} ^{ghost}
another cold day could not get the bread mixed for having
with the turkeys. sent 3 to butter 28 - 98 pan-kills 25
3 loaves bread 15 - cup tanger 25 - lbs cheese 16 2 ^{the} candy 14
my lb. for Margaret & one box Margaret's box what we owe her
