Cloudy. Frosty storm and snowing not very cold. We spread 4 loads manure AM No 7 W and in PM put 35 poles up in henhouse and put straw between them and roof. Willie down town with Nell in cutter got at Armstrongs groceries 65 cts (weighing about 16<sup>th</sup> 2 cts) then Mary took Nell and she and Martha Bondy went collecting for B.A. Bill Mutch over at night with ads Mr Ritchie clipped from paper about sale of Holstein cows Mutch sold their place yesterday to Mr Madie.

Snowing heavy AM sunny PM pretty stormy We put tar paper in henhouse etc AM and in PM Willie and I drove over to Elora gave order for window then went to Mrs Marshall to see his Holstein cows. Girds down town PM got at Russells dry goods \$1.50 at Phillips Toys 40 stamps 10 sent for Cottonmillent \$1.03 meat Hartman 30 cts (Sathorne \$1.50 calendars 95 Phillips paper) On Dec 8<sup>th</sup> Girds paid in Russell of 54 65 less 12 34 added by mistake Nov 19<sup>th</sup> \$47.31 freight of apple up to Dec 4<sup>th</sup>.

Willie down at night got sent Hartman 20. paid Armstrongs of in full \$16.92 cash for chickens sold Nov 23 12 51 sick Stabs 15 cts. I worked at henhouse etc to-day. Mary sent some presents away to Newtons to-day. Sugar 25 lbs
