

Croton November 1887

¹⁰ Fri Nov ^{11th} Snow most of the day. I was covering potato and apple pits a topping turnips.

Walter was plowing. Victoria improving.

Sat Nov ^{12th} cloudy and snow in the fore noon. I was topping and pitting turnips.

Walter was plowing.

Sun Nov ^{13th} clear fore part of the day, cloudy this evening.

Mon Nov ^{14th} cloudy part of the day part clear and warm. I was choring about the ~~two~~ house. Walter plowing.

Tue Nov ^{15th} cloudy and soft. I was making cider in the fore noon. after noon was over the river cleaning out brush and sticks out of the ditch. Walter was plowing.

Wed Nov ^{16th} clear and pleasant for the time of year. I was cleaning away the brush in the garden that was blown down in the summer. and cleaning out water furrows. Walter finished fall plowing.

Croton November 1887

Thu Nov ^{17th} cloudy windy and cold was gathering apples part of the day. part of the day blocking up the old cow stable. Walter was fencing the stalk stacks.

Fri Nov ^{18th} clear and cold wind from the west.

Walter and the girls went to Thamesville.

I was cleaning water furrows in the fall ^{plowing}

Sat Nov ^{19th} Snow in the fore noon rain this evening. we were not doing much to day.

Sun Nov ^{20th} cloudy and snow most of the day. a poor turnout to church.

Mon Nov ^{21st} cloudy and cool. we butchered a pig, and was getting the cattle housed. Victoria getting better was out in the dining room ^{part} of the day.

Tue Nov ^{22nd} a smokey moderate day. I took some wheat ^{to} Thamesville and exchanged for ^{flour}

Wed Nov ^{23rd} a smokey foggy day. was exchanging corn for barley with Charly Mack this fore noon. after after noon putting up grain to get chopt.
