for bread Jim was in brought me in three bags
of potatoes I did not pay him for them Jim
Frank & J. G. Tye were here for tea Mrs Wilson
stayed with baby while Mary & I went for drive
was a nice day have to night 4.07 cts.

23rd Went to church in morn & eve 20 cts
went to Mr. Philip Heaslip's funeral in after. noon
it stormed a little and was quite cold

24th Stayed around the house in fore-noon I drove
Mrs E. and Bradley out to cemetery in after-noon
I went up to Mrs Mc Carthys on Howe Island in
