

Thomas Cameron Island Dec the 4th 1866
Propellers came up I went to Mr Harper's Bought
3rd of Tallow at 7 1/2 per lb 8 3/4 a treat or 2 paid this and
Sweetys went to Williamstown 5th in Williamstown 6th
Came from Williamstown Bargained with Mrs. Munroe
about 6 sheep on the Halves took Dinner at
Thomas Munroes Bought of Mr Hill Bottle of
Whiskey and a Treat paid this 1 Bag of Flour 4 1/2 1/2 lb Tea
2 1/2 lb Mustard 10 1/2 1/2 lb finger 1 1/2 glass for Lamp 1 1/2
3 Quarts of Oil 10 1/2 1 Quart of Whiskey and Treat 1/3 an axe
handle in my canoe left by some one and took my tin
Basin away no light in Mr Hills Light house
last night Johnsons and M^{rs} Lees lights up yet 2
Boats passed one up with a Tow and a Propeller
went down Barker Towed up with her the Advan
up to Cornwall the Propeller that went down got aground
the Bruno near the new Light House 7th Thomas
Munroe came down with the 6 sheep the 2 Boys with
him Packing the store in a Bore to Fetch to Williamstown
To-bacco Pepper 2 pair of spectacles Hughlins hair
2 californica Hats Stone axe Indian Flint Wild Turnip cels
Hags Hooks 8th caught the sheep and the Bore took over
Thomas Munroes left them there took Dinner there
Bought of Mr Harper 1/2 lb saleratus or soda and
Treat 1/6 paid this Raining Hard East Wind
changed to South Wind a Steamer went down today
light in Mr Lees yet and Johnsons Wild Geese and Ducks
8th Sunday a Steamer came up a Barge in
Tow a Boat Passed with 4 or 5 men going
Lancaster 10th Whitewashing inside and outside
fixing slats on the Door up stairs very cold
went for cedar the Big Ram with Thomas
Monday 12th cutting stove Wood a canoe
crossed the helter 1 man in them 13 This is the Day
men men to be hiring in Toronto taking the
one out of the ice

took the 2 young Rams from the Bell Point cold
Frosty weather 15th Drawing Drags cold East Wind and
snow through the night 16th Sunday cold to Day 17th
cold stormy went to the Head of the Island for the
sheep the Big Ram along with them Thomas
sheep feeding the cattle extra turned a little
milder Ducks plenty 18th chopping stove Wood 15th stormy
Drawing Drags drew some of the sticks from around the garden
to the grove 20th cutting stove Wood Frosty Day and
last night froze out to the edge of the Mushes feeding
the cattle extra Horse out to Day seen Wild Geese
going West culmy Thumbs with the Drawing knife
frinding the axe 21st Feeding the 2 young Rams with
good Hay and the calf went around the Island
ice taken to the Little Island North Side its turned
warm some or the ice would take This is the first day
of Winter and a Fine Day it is Besides other
years east Wind Made 13 candles out of
Tallow as yet Fixing the Dried currants Dried grapes Dried
apples Dried elder Berries and Black Berries Raspberries
22nd Feeding the Horses with carrots cutting stove
Wood a fine Day the ice took from the end of
our Mushes to Kops Island Brooke on a
cake of Sugar 14 lb to Day Gordon plays
in the snow all Day with his sleigh
23rd Cooking Rice 24th Cooking Cakes and preparing for
Christmas Eve Made a shaft for the sleigh ice
up 25th Christmas Day a Fine Day
Began snowing towards evening I went out in the
small Canoe up to the Bay Wind West seen
one on the Water to Day But myself 26th Working
the shaft putting it together 27th put the shaft on the
sleigh Went to the Bush Gordon and I took home
Wood Took home a Load of Cedar for 13 room
fixing Canoes water Raising East Wind storm
