Girls called on Mrs Jno Black who has been sick then went down town got at Fouts canned tomatoes 25 tea 20 milk 14 Jno Black brought 30 posts @ 16 a piece and one anchor 25cts paid him on them \$5.00 Father up in morning. Turned frosty again last night - snowing and stormy calmer in evening sunny & cloudy We cut wood on circular saw in AM & PM Willie took what we cut down home in wagon he also took 905 lbs pig chop to Wilsons. He got at M^c Dermotts collars mended 70cts paid got single buggy harness mending 75cts on a/c at Mills meat 25cts at Armstrongs on a/c Jimmie haddie 28 cows out 5cts

Frosty stormy sunny. Willie went down town in AM took some straw to "Stub" Graham got chop at Wilsons 45cts got on a/c at Armstrongs goods 19cts 1/2 ton bran \$9.30 1/2 ton shorts \$10.00. We split and piled the two loads of cut wood in wood shed. Willie drove Mrs Robertson "Piknie" and Mrs Forsythe up here in PM also mother with Jimmie in cutter they stayed for tea. Willie drove them over to Elora after tea. They are going to Perryhouse this week.
