5		<p>Monday</p> <p>Cloudy morning a few drops snow cleared off fine sunny day. Wm Inidale J. F and W.S. up all day we almost finished turnips. hauled 18 more or less loads to pit &amp; to roothouse. Paid boys in full \$2.00. Girls called on Mrs Bunting and Mrs Sars. coal oil Russ 46</p>		2 00 46
6		<p>Tuesday</p> <p>Fine sunny day. Frost last night. We finished our turnips to-day 3 loads to roothouse and covered the pit. We hauled rape land in 107 twice and brought over load mangels from pit.</p>		
7		<p>Wednesday</p> <p>Fine sunny day. Frost last night. Willie took straw to Graham brought 1/2 load manure on spreader filled it at stable spread it and another on No 1. I made wire fence around pit. In P.M. we plowed No 2 sod and laid corn tils under drain. Girls down town P.M. got meat 25¢ bread 13¢ paint Mennis 45¢. They called on Mrs Pick who is unwell. We went down to horse meeting round chamber at night. Mrs Maywood married to-day Miss Rowe</p>		83
