

Finished sowing wheat sowed in all about $7\frac{1}{2}$ bushels
on something like 3 acres. Received from James Shua
2 Dollars on his account.

Wednesday 16th. Fine. Father Robert and Phil planting
potatoes. Phil finished dragging in wheat. Fred cutting
potatoes. Put up a pig yard. C milled setting plow in
pail on Shuck's account 1.10 & on the 14th

Thursday 17th. Fine but cool. Dragging potatoe plant-
ing, levelling, cleaning out cellar. 8 bushels of potatoe
planted. Thrashing barley, sowed some.

Friday 18th. Fine, warm, wind easterly by dusk.
Finished thrashing barley, 6 bushels. Cleaned up barley
oats $3\frac{1}{2}$ and wheat 6 bushels. Levelling and burning bush.
Finished sowing and digging in barley 3 bushels.
Took the pigs off two of them. 12 eggs of herring
of J Goble $7\frac{1}{2}$ d. N.P.

Saturday 19th. Fine, warm. 10 herrings of Iden
Goble 7th d. Burning bush, cleaning up straw and
stuff round. Laid riders on fence. next row
fell her two barrels home from sugar boiling
place. got barley straw home. Did hunting over
sleigh horses.

Sunday 20th. Fine.

Monday 21st. Fine and warm. Burning bush,
cutting fence logs. Sowed some oats, digging, had
one bushel of oats of J. Goble which makes good
had, he wishes to be repaid in oats after harvest. Cal
Wrost of Iden Goble 1 shilling N.P.

Tuesday 22. Fine and warm. Burning bush
chopping fence logs, dragging. half a dozen herrings
of Iden.

Wednesday 23rd. Thunder and rain in morning
fine and hot during the day. chopping up trees, burning
bush. Making fence between Shuck and one. Phil
over on at Shuck's logging 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ of wood of Iden at 13
cents per lb. Mother went to store spent for shirting
and one pound of coffee 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ qd.

Thursday 24th. Fine and pleasant
