- April 1 Went to Brockville from Lyn with Norton Gardner
in the cutter came home on the carriage all well
- 2 drew 2 loads of wood from Armstrong's
- 3 worked in the sugar bush attended an agricultural meeting
there is a fine run of sap to day put about 50 pails
in the stone trough besides what we backed down
- 4 the Revd Mr. Auld preached in the evening
- 5 drew 2 loads of wood from Armstrongs then went to
the Council meeting had frost last night & to day
- 6 worked in the sugar bush the sap we put in the
trough all leaked out & last there is a fine run ^{to} to day
- 7 felled all day in the bush fine day
- 8 Do. do. do
- 9 Do. do. do. Billie went to a Bee of snow
James Colhoun this afternoon a little flurries of
- 10 hard frost last night cleaned up the wheat
put 12 bushel in the east barn & in the center pen
- 11 no meeting to day hard frost last night
- 12 worked in the sugar bush the sap runs mighty
- 13 Do. do. Sowed grass seed on the Rye
- 14 Billie got 1300 of hay from Charles Armstrong
the Revd Mr Baker stopped here on his way to Europe
he brought us plones & spaccification for the church
- 15 worked in the bush finished sowing grass seed
on the Rye ^{& wheat} 8 bushels of the Red clover seed
with the Thimothy seed the wheat a Rye look ^{up}
- 16 drew dung to the trees for mulching
- rain 17 a little rain this morning worked in the
sugar bush fine day
- 18 the Revd Mr Auld preached this forenoon in
the school house
- 19 heavy rain last night & this morning the
boys worked at Sheppard drawing stumps I
went with Wm Armstrong to look at a line
between here & Filler
