Mon June 26th clear and cool. I went to Dresden with Dicks wife. I was noticing the the crops wheat, oats, and barley. looking good clover a big crop. Some fields of corn shows the woss for the wet

Tue June 27th clear and cool I was hoeing corn G. H. Paul and wife and Mary called in

Wed June 28th clear and cool. I went over to see my Brother John who is very poorly I sett a hen this morning on wyondol eggs

Thu June 29th clear and pleasant. I went with Brothe John to Florence. I went to settle withinny for a coal stove he was not at home

Fri June 30th clear and pleasant. Sarah was here this fore noon doing house work Thomas Cragg was here for pay for the coal I got from him last winter I paid him

Sat July 1st cloudy a smart shower about noon. I hoed up my last year Strawberry patch. Sarah brought me a loaf of bread

Sun July 2nd cloudy and warm. was down to Sunday School

Mon July 3rd cloudy and warm. Bilton call this fore noon. a prospect of more rain

Tue July 4th high wind and flying clouds. thunder and lightning and heavy rain last night and a heavy shower again to night. I pick a few berries this fore noon
