Mostly cloudy but considerable sunshine cold wind but thawing. I took 6 pigs down sold to J. Black for \$100.00 did not weigh them. I brought Hugh Cameron up with me he got dinner here J Johnstone meat man called for him and took him up to Arthur. I cleaned seed oats P.M. we also dropped a little horse. Willie not better yet.

Friday

Fine sunny day frosty but thawing in sunshine Messrs Mr Lester and Cameron in A.M. bought Sir Perry, Quorn steer Myrtle steer for 7 ds Tand 1/8 Is also Schanis red for 7 ds \$1.50 back to go next Saturday Rec on them \$2.00 W. late came in but turned back again when he saw them, I finished cleaning the 5 bushels seed oat for seed fair then took 5 bushels each of oats peas & barley also 1 bag Connet potatoes down to seed fair. While down there Mr Morton's funeral passed town hall from station to cemetery (formerly English church meeting) P.M. I got ride down with Bob Lindale to seed fair Mr was speaker same as last year spoke on milage etc we got 1st prize for barley & potatoes 3rd for oats nothing for peas, came to \$5.50 I got cheque for Amelie Montgoye from J Beattie \$74.25 sold J Caldwell bag potatoes Connet 1st prize \$1.00 Willie drove girls over to meeting at Barbons P.M. then brought team down we took up grain again. Mary came down and stayed all night. We found a sheep head this morning in sheep house. John Allfanga anchored off the grain.
