 ret'd wire 40^c. bgt hand axe. 45 40
 sold some cabbage. 2 doz
 to W. Redwin. 2 doz to precious
 2 doz. Lillis & Hadden, 1 doz to Jackson
 4 doz to. Mitchell. 1 doz to Seroggie
 Sold all potatoes we have to
 spare to W. Sharp at 95^c &
 our small ones at 50^c

Good Friday 1st April 1904

W. Chord in morning &
 scraped apple trees in afternoon
