

Camden Gore May 1883

Tue May 23<sup>rd</sup> clear was letting water of the corn ground of the barley this fore noon after noon went up to Florence with B. D. Snarey.

Thu May 24<sup>th</sup> clear most of the day and hot, a sharp frost last night. cloudy this evening we was repairing fences making a pen for washing the sheep.

Fri May 25<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. John and Anne went to Dresden. I was helping to clear the Organ. the fruit trees are blossoming.

Sat ~~Apr~~ May 26<sup>th</sup> heavy rain most of the day, not doing much to day.

Sun May 27<sup>th</sup> cloudy and thunder showers went South and West none here.

Mon May 28<sup>th</sup> cloudy, hot part of the day not doing much the ground to wet to work went to Florence this after noon.

Tue May 29<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant, the ground to wet yet to work, we was repairing fence part of the day, the apple trees only nicely in bloom.

Wed May 30<sup>th</sup> cloudy, after noon rain. commenced putting up a piece of board fence had to stop at noon for the rain.

Thu May 31<sup>st</sup> clear and cool, John and James Stagg's was working at the fence, I went to Dresden this fore noon for nails.

Camden Gore June 1883

Fri June 1<sup>st</sup> clear and hot in the middle of the day, James Stagg's John & myself working at the board fence by the side of the lane, and a frost last night.

Sat June 2<sup>nd</sup> clear and warm I was ~~repa~~ repairing fence this fore noon, after noon we were washing sheep.

Sun June 3<sup>rd</sup> cloudy in the after noon, and warm.

Mon June 4<sup>th</sup> flying clouds and hot, heavy thunder showers last night, this fore noon I went over the river to get Mr Skinner to shear the sheep, after noon the boys and I took the young cattle over to the other place and made some fence posts and brought home.

Tue June 5<sup>th</sup> clear fore part of the day and hot, heavy thunder and rain this evening, I was planting beans and corn in the garden the fore part of the day, latter part selling seed corn, John commenced harrowing the corn ground.

Wed June 6<sup>th</sup> flying clouds most of the day, heavy rain in the evening went up to Florence this fore noon, clearing a load of wheat for Mill in the after noon John commenced to harrow in the after noon was stoppt by the rain.
