It is a mistake to suppose that the menopause is normally associated with unusual loss of blood. It is a fatal mistake to administer ergot in cases of genital hemorrhage without having taken the precaution of making first a digital examination to discover the cause. Numbers of inoperable cervical carcinomas are sent to gynecologists with a history of having been treated with ergot for a long time without an examination having been made.
