I went down this afternoon to dig Aunt Alice's potatoes but as it was pretty late when I got the calves watered I didn't get many dug. I went for a swim before I came home. Quint has bought an old Ford car and is going around to the Fall fair selling. That Dags he went to Caguna yesterday.

Saturday September 3rd

Dad ploughed all day again and got quite a nice lot done. I spent most of the morning just doing chores. Aunt Alice came over this morning with the awful news that Cousin Hall

was dead. She was as well this morning as she has been for a long time and was walking down the street with Cousin Clara who had gone over to ask her to go to Simcoe with her this afternoon. They parted about opposite the Stom's house and before Cousin Hall got to her own house, she fell. Mr. Bayley & Mr. Stom were up at the corner and saw her lying on the grasses - ran down but she was unconscious and died in a few minutes. Of course Aunt Alice and Aunty felt terribly. Each drove Aunty down this afternoon and she stayed down. Mary & I drove Joe down and Mary took the Church money to the bank and I dug some more potatoes. At four o'clock I went for a swim with Sid.

Mary, Sid and I went down to Sunday school & Church and Dad & Euch went down to Church. Dad, Euch & Sid stayed down at Aunty's for dinner and Euch stayed down for tea. Mary & I came home and I did up the noon chores and we drove Luise down to meet the three o'clock car as Mary expected her. Dad
