June 25<sup>th</sup>. Picked first strawberries 13 x 36 pints sold in Toronto at ~~21 to 25%~~ <sup>netted ~~21 to 25%~~</sup> 891.00 would have had a few more but rained again

June 26<sup>th</sup> Hoeing. had another thunder shower at noon.

Jan 27<sup>th</sup> Sunday fine went for a car ride out to Carlisle & Cedar Springs

Jan 28<sup>th</sup>. Picking strawberries shipped 42 crates pints at noon to Toronto sold 12 crates at 14¢ and shipped 31 crates 9 to Toronto at night.

June 29<sup>th</sup>. Picked 55 x 27 crates of strawberries sold at 20¢ here had a thunder shower at five o'clock and some rain and hail about 7 o'clock. the largest hail I ever saw some as large as pigeons eggs good job there was not many of them cut one crate of cabbage for the first.

June 30<sup>th</sup>. Picked 59 crates strawberries shipped to Toronto sold at 20 to 23 cts picked 3 light sweet cherries. sold @ \$1.00 light

July 1<sup>st</sup> Picked 92 crates strawberries sold to R.L. Scott (here) at 16¢
