August, drew in from the field below the little orchard a little shower this afternoon

- 2 mowed in the 2nd field front of the house watie cut the fall wheat that was winter ^{helped}
- 3 bound & stook the fall wheat in forenoon went to Mallory town to the Election voted for Mr Benjamin Tett in preference to Mr DeLong
- 4 mowed in the corn field Robert Armstrong helped & little rain this afternoon
- 5 finished the corn field & raked part of it no mowing to day
- 6 mowed the Thompson place
- 8 made a stack at the New Barn and cut the large oats below the Bull pasture & the grass seed
- 9 cut the peas & oats & drew in the large oats & drew in the remains of the grass seed & that finished our hay
- 10 hooked the large peas bound the peas & oats ~~very~~ very dry weather
- 11 cut the Scotch wheat on the Thompson place & part of the wheat in corn field
- 12 finished the wheat in the corn field & hooked peas
- 13 Mr Fletcher preached in canton
- 14 hooked peas very dry wheather
- 15 began to cut the oats on the crest place rather green
- 16 worked at the peas
- 17 Do Do Do
- 18 worked at the oats
- 19 Do Do Do
