Maternal Nephritis and Nursing.

Women who have been subjects of puerperal eclampsia should not be allowed to nurse until at least one week has passed since the subsidence of the symptoms. During the illness the kidneys do not eliminate normally and toxic material accumulates, which brings about an alteration of the milk secretion, more or less in proportion to the severity of the attack.—*Francioni; Archives of Pediatrics.*
