Gordon Fernandez and John Ho
all came Brought me a Book
from Dan Frasher Turned very
Windy from the West some Rain

a very fine Day Gordon and Fernandez
crossed Lots of Water on the Ice
Felling the Sugar Bush Digging
to the Camp First Boiling to
Day Drawing Wood to the camp
Randolph cut his Foot
on the ankle some Blackbirds
and heard a March Robin On
this Day of ^{the} Month D. Mc Master
Fernox first came to the Island
unfortunate Day got a Lot of
Papers in the Mail I think from
Uncle John's girls 13th Fine & Wind
some grains of snow fell I went
up to the Sugar Bush a flock of
Wild Geese lit on the ice before
the poor Raining hard to night
14th Starry B Day 1880 Blowing
drifting snowed some Drawing
wood to the camp Sapt some
yesterday making some spoils found a
knife went to get 2 lbs got none
Froze hard to night ice looks good
15th Fine & Wind took home 5 Gallons
of thin stuff 3 Boys in the Bush Boiling
16th Rain Snow Seander went to Dundee
sold 2 Fox skins 2.70 for them Bought of
1.70 Powder and shot peling the Boards
in an A
