

Fri 12 9 p.m. after the rain Tom McNeowan threshing Arthur  
helping I churned & worked the butter canned up the last  
of the grapes peeled a big kettle of pears I peeled the  
pumpkin I put it through the colander. Therefore I Gordon  
guarded the cows. Margorie washed a quilt a lot for herself  
& the children I did not want her to wash any for me for I am  
going to wash next week. I swept the school house. The children  
Sat to Marguerie went up to Ackmers therefore guarded the cows  
until she came back. I killed two roosters & dressed them  
for Hester they weighed 6 lbs they made them less. Took 8.44  
of butter they made 12 oz short - Herkin 15. hard 14 gal oil 18  
soyelling 30 sugar 25 fly paper 5 Soda 5 ginger 10 soap 5  
yeast 5 Balance of 12. put 243 on the book. Marguerie got the  
horse up & fed her & we got the wagon out. I swept both rooms  
cleaned the kitchen washed the windows made 14 pumpkin pies  
& one grape - cleaned the shirts. Boiled pig feed. Margorie  
swept the front room. Arthur finished threshing then went  
to George Ackmers for the rest of the day. Maggie went to  
town for 1 doz eggs a qt. a lb tea & 2 " Will came home  
from Berlin he took Hattie up yesterday. I got a lot of  
wood up from the flats. Margorie got a lb Bolina 9 2.2 & meat  
Bun 11. in church here. Arthur in Recanage Mrs R has been  
sick. Annie went to the brick

Mon 13 beautifull day hard frost last night. I went down  
& dusted the school house brought up a 12 qt pail of  
water the children guarded the cows in the forenoon while  
Margorie went after the turnips seed then she was sewing  
for Marguerie she had rheumatism bad. I churned after  
dinner worked the butter. in the morning we drewed up  
a barrel of water Arthur in Georges. I went over to see  
Mrs Recanage after I had my night work done

Tue 13 Will went to Port Robinson with a big load of chopping  
9 bushels of wheat - let us have two bushels for flour. I put 10  
bushels of wheat screening 9 wheat in two sacks & 3 1/2 bushels  
& Margorie went to Chippawa. I got a chopped wood 4 1/3 of bushels  
& 25 got half 10 brown sugar 18 cheese 19. flour 5. flour blacking &  
lard 10 rice 10 coffee 13 tea 12. eggs 5. peppermint 5. Arthur up  
the Ackmers. Annie helping clean the church Berlin & Hester in  
Wills. The Presbyterian minister called at the other house I  
started to wash in the forenoon by the time she dashed separator is  
washed floor swept & wood picked up to keep feed for the  
pigs boiled one cannt. got much else done made a pudding  
for dinner. got the white cloths washed & put to soak  
Wed 14. Margorie & Gordon guarded the cow. Marguerie went  
down until the got the bread mixed. I carried a pail from  
the school house for the chum. I churned & worked the butter  
she went up to help Mrs. Mr. Erdie after dinner. wind terribly high  
terrible for baking & hot & smoky I put the white cloths out.  
Arthur & his father went over to Willocks after the all in the afternoon  
Arthur went to Georges. I separated the milk just got through  
as Will came to do it he is so good about coming does it  
about every night since Arthur has been to George & othersomes  
so I went down & swept the schoolhouse but did not dust.  
Thur 15. Will & Sally went to Chippawa. Annie over for awhile  
I washed out my blanket she got stained by the drip on it  
& a lot of calicos just about washed gathered up a lot of  
wood along the flats dashed the schoolhouse & carried  
two pails of water yesterday Margorie & I drewed a barrel  
Arthur in Georges. The heat is great. & the dry wind high  
Margorie & Gordon guarded the cows morning & Marguerie & I  
Friday 16 I churned. Had a bread pudding for dinner. Margorie  
kept the pigs out of the hen while I beat ed it time the cleaned
