we made about 50 lbs sugar and

22 The S. S. children were to a sugar feast at Wm Campbell's
Maple Hill,

23 Murdy came home this evening. I sowed cabbage seed, and
some carrots buto mangedds. sowed part of a square, set a hen

24 got 8 loaves = 40 Washed some of the plaster in boys room. 40

25 I was in church in the morning and at Prayers in the
evening in Heppelbath. where J. M. Bain gave a short
address and prayers very ^{pleasant} good. ^{to} Jimmie 25cts for Orphan

26 finished the boys room & washed the spare room 25

27 Bought at Duns 4 yds check 15 = 60. two pair ^{one pair} hose to 32cts
one pair sold Sandy McEntyre 2 1/2 lbs butter 50 cts

Pa paid an old account since winter at Duns 2.77
it is raining began about 6.30 P.M. Got Bird's boots from Pigon
gave him 1/2 cord wood 75 cts.

28 gave Pigon 5 lbs butter to help pay boots. The butter is 20 cts
Mr. lb. King boots came home today. Far got our account
from M. Thurson, 4. I was at Prayer Meeting! 70 5 loaves 25 cts

29 sold 2 1/2 lbs butter 20 = 50. 1 1/2 yds of brown ribbon 19 cts

30 Taking up potatoes got 4 loaves 20 cts
