August 15 cut a piece of the oats in the North west corner of the North field very warm & dry ^{for the cows}

- 16 Mr Wm Beck preached this morning Mr Ferguson at night
- 17 Ad went to gononogue with Bessie she is going to school there bought 400 of flour \$2.75 per 100 got home at noon Wallace McKel came with him they drew in 2 loads of oats from the old house & 1 from the North field David brought Ellen ^{she is} home he
- 18 Ad helped Bruce McKel at his wheat 3 cords ^{Ad did nothing yet}
- 19 cut the wheat in the North field the South end was a fair crop the rest was rather light Wallace McKel & Robert Whorby helped fine day
- rain 20 rain last night & this morning Ad cut some oats in the north field the afternoon
- 21 Ad helped Bruce McKel at his wheat
- 22 Do Do ^{at} with his oats
- 23 Revd Mr Ferguson preached this morning & the Revd Mr Cunningham at night I went out for the first time this forenoon
- 24 Ad raked up some oats this forenoon Wallace McKel helped him to draw in 2 loads this afternoon
- 25 Ad & Wallace drew in the wheat had 3 loads this forenoon Ad finished cutting the oats
- 26 Ad helped Wallace to get in his oats
- 27 Ad helped Bruce to bind oats
- 28 Do Do Do in the forenoon Watt & Seize come down on the morning Express from the West Watt was at Anataha Seize was up to Sardara to visit Mother Ellen went up to Gononogue for Bessie Billie come home from Lembroads this afternoon he is going to stay ^{here}
- 29 Ad went to Delta with Watt & Seize this morning Lommer went home with them very dry weather Ad got home about 11 o'clock at night
- 30 Revd Mr Cunningham preached this morning & Mr Ferguson at night
- 31 Ad helped Bruce McKel to draw in oats & peas very dry here Billie went to Delta this afternoon Polley & the Bessie
