Suggestions in Surgical Diseases of the Kidney—No. 1.

Cloudy urine does not always mean pus. The opacity may be due to an excess of some of the chemical constituents, as phosphates or urates. Remember that phosphates will clear up with the addition of acid, and that boiling the sample will dissolve the urates. The glass test, where the cloudiness is due to pus, will be of some importance in reaching an opinion regarding its source.—Bremerman; *Int. Journ. of Surg.*
