17 Old Mrs M Leman (S. J.'s mother) died Wednesday afternoon after a short illness. She was buried here this evening. I colored carpet rug today. we got 20 lbs sugar charged at Willis 1⁰⁰ and a file for mowing knife 1.20 I took 3 1/4 lbs steak from Carr. charged Our boys are going to Huntington tomorrow to play lacrosse

18 I forgot to write of the banquet the village gave McCormick on the 16th at Sullivan. the toasts were drunk with cold water. some one took away the ink so I must write with red. The boys went off at 5 Walter Slack took them to Lancaster and went for game in the evening. It rained through the day and in the evening

19 It rained a good deal last night and is raining some today

20 Bull, pa came home about 4 P.M.

21 Boys cut some hay.

22 Wednesday I boiled black currants and raspberries. got 18 lb granulated sugar at Willis 1⁰⁰ charged got 6 qts curris 5-30. 1/2 lb tea 25- 1/2 lb tea 5-10 codfish 30. bread & buns 25 postage 1

23 It began to rain, the boys got 1 load of hay in then it rained all day

24 Fair in forenoon, Cousin Jimmie came home by the mail. He got a watch for Randolph
