We cleaned seed barley took fully off circular saw fixed manure spreader Miss Daly down PM helped Bell cut out 5 shirts for Patriotic Society. Mary called on Mrs Cook PM ~~was~~ collecting for B.S. also on Mrs Ford Bowly.

Mr Argo was given his presents after church meeting for being Missionary Sea for 52 years among others Bessie Milne joined the church. We gave coll 10c also \$1.50 for the girls present. Girls got meat 45c at Shortreids also at Russell's on apr dress goods \$9.00 I drove 7-8 M home from church then took circular saw shaft up to Beath's factory to get pulley put on. Uncle Jim came home to-day.
