at night there was no one come for Mr Nicholson
- 8 Ad cut the Rye this afternoon Mr Nicholson is
away on the Express & so did David Ad went to
for him. Rose & Jessie yesterday he got a telegram
- 9 I put Poengreen on the potatoes this forenoon
& went to Kingston on the Express to the Presbyterian
there was a good many Ministers & Elders there they
worked till after ten o'clock P.M. Started at Citeck
- 10 got home this afternoon the Presbyterian rate two hundred
dined dollars of a supply to Lansdowne & Fairfax
- Ad & Wallace drew in 2 loads of Rye put it in
west half of the big mow he cut the grass in that field
- 11 finished in the Northwest part of the North field grass
is poor raked part of it I went to see the Orange men
walk at the Station there was a large crowd &
a great many speeches made in our woods.
- 12 the Methodest & the Church of England got up
dinner for them the Methodest invited the church of
England & got the most of the orange men
