Four Common Types of Heart Disease—No. 1.

I. The rheumatic group.

Here are included the cases associated with (a) rheumatic fever, (b) chorea, (c) acute tonsilitis, and (d) "primary endocarditis" with negative Wassermann reaction. The trend of recent investigation indicates that a streptococcus is responsible for all these types, affecting most often the pericardium, myocardium and mitral valve. The characteristic valve lesion is mitral stenosis.—*Cabot; J. A. M. A.*
