14 Fine soft day, a little snow falling, until 3 P.M. when it cleared up beautifully. There was a D^r Suttin in the village for two days. He was pulling teeth without pain. Murdy went for Far

15 Monday I made a flannel washing. Pa & Murdy are drawing wood for the furnace

16 We had a pretty good meeting at the Lodge last night. I baked bread today. Marv had a letter from Cousin Jimmie. He will be home on Friday. Hatty came about dusk and got a chance back again.

17 Drawing wood. Sander butchered his cow in our barn. Murdy went to meet Jimmie at Lancaster. He is coming up on the maccaron. Auntie sent for oat meal 25^{cts}

18 Thursday Pa & Murdy went to Morris Mills with oats for meal

19 Cold Cousin Jimmie came and is looking well

20 Auntie bot \$1⁰⁰ gran sugar 1 lb tea. 1 box crackers 1 bottle essence cinnamon 10

21 Wet all day a good many to church. not many in evening

22 Fine day but slippery. Got getting shod. paid it and \$4⁰⁰ on our old acc. Old Archy Grant J. Branch was buried this morning & Peter Grant of Lancaster Village was buried in the afternoon

23 Lilly McGillis was buried this morning

 wms 45 salt 20 65
