I had Mrs Corie washing this afternoon Pa and Jimmie were in the Bazaar, out to Sandy's, up at G. M. Galloway this forenoon, no word from Martha's Niece day two Marys from the home were to Temple today

- 18 Kept Bird at home and she done a little washing, it rained so much Pa did not go to Cornwall, had a letter from Ann she will be home tomorrow
- 19 Tuesday Annie & Elizabeth came home today by the mail, I am still pretty bad with the gall black strap 2 lb granulate sugar
- 21 We were up most part of the night
- 22 Burton's house took fire about 8 o'clock P.M. it burned a good deal about the roof they put out the fire as they supposed but they did not stop in the house for most of their bedding was taken out then about 1 o'clock in the morning the fire broke out again and before people could get out the whole house was in flames we were in a flurry
