 went up home then took team to church shed Kate

 25cts saw J.C.T re missing report got team  
 went to Nichols got 5 galons gasoline \$12.5 then to  
 mill got chop 34cts and 500 lbs white dust \$6.25  
 Saw No 1 pigged to night 13 12 living put them in boxes  
 829 got up through night to feed them.

18 Tuesday

Cold frosty stormy day. sunny and cloudy. I worked  
 at putting fibre board on wall behind kitchen door.  
 Willie fixed at engine took big wheel off to turn half  
 gear wheel. Clarence Taylor in PM to see if  
 Marshall Day wanted to buy a farm. Willie  
 gave mother \$10.00 sometime ago Mary spending it

19 Wednesday

Snowing heavy in morning and AM. cleared  
 off sunny PM frosty day. I finished putting  
 fibre board behind kitchen door Willie worked  
 at fixing engine. Mr Cook over PM fanned  
 his oats he is getting from us.

20 Thursday

Not frosty, cloudy mizzling almost raining.  
 Willie drove down in morning got at  
 P M. Gregors on dc 280 lbs store & fumes coal brought  
 up 7.M. & Mary. We spread 4 loads manure from slaps

140 on No 1. I also spread from Durims which Willie brought up PM after taking 700 lbs

Mary changed up. We clipped a little. Mary got at W. Jones goods \$1.20 cards & stamps
