Pd Hamilton \$14⁰⁰ for Dr. Insurance for 3 mos 11.00

Saturday 21st fair

We finished hoeing turnips & cut
around wheat field. &
I went to town. got shoes \$3⁵⁰ 3.50
hardware. 40^c p. sent \$15⁰⁰ 40
15.00
to see Mr Farlane. recd 3
got brushes \$1⁴⁵ foot chn 25 1.45
Paid Joe W^c Grogan \$2⁰⁰ last night 2.00
had W. W^c Lean hoeing turnips at
7¹/₂ c per row.

Sunday 22nd hot & showery

Mother Jannie & I went
to Church in morning.
We enjoyed a very practical
sermon from Dr Henderson
on Brethren Count it all
joy when ye fall into divers
temptations. We all stayed
at home the rest of the
day

Monday 23rd

Started to-day for
the West. Fisk cutting
wheat.

Finished cutting wheat -
