in his wheat then began cutting Oct 2 & 3  
Mary went to the mill to dinner then  
called at G. Bork's had dinner a heart &  
kisses his wife is quite poorly then  
went to Henry's & stayed all night at  
2 we came home to M. Miller came  
with us he stays a few days Boy &  
grain it was a little drier at times  
Yesterday today it was fine & clear  
quite warm P.M. 3 Boy & Benji & his  
Man finished cutting the last of the grain  
till about 4 P.M. then they went home &  
I cut the spring wheat W. clear warm  
cloudy P.M. a slight shower at bedtime  
P. E. brought David Martin & wife from  
Pennsylvania for a call P.M.  
4 Boys drove along with 4 waggoners at 8  
3 P.M. Boys helped all day & flour  
A.M. they drove on Knoll & on Meadows  
ground Jennie Stines was here to day  
W. a very stormy night heavy rain heavy  
thunder & lightning Comes D. in morning came  
was struck & killed it struck an Oak  
tree & fence Post in our back lane  
heard today that Dr. Robinson was found  
lying dead in his house he died of a Paralysis  
stroke 5 Boy helped Benji drive along A.M.  
they helped flour drive along P.M. 7 P.M.  
I & Mary went with the Joes to the mill  
Lavinia called P.M. Lewis at night  
night 6 Boys helped Benji cut out with  
Blind & team W. cloudy A.M. clear P.M.  
Cool air I went to Cedar Grove this morning  
& brought home just from Mill  
the boy & Mary went to the fair to see  
boy born about 4 A.M. all well we stayed  
the old man & woman

Aug 1910  
I & a white Henry to dinner Frank  
Grove came to stay a few days W. fine  
cool air a warm sun a little cloudy  
8 I helped Benji thresh I & Eliza drove  
in 3 loads mixed grain & oats & spread  
up things ready to thresh tomorrow I asked  
some hands to help thresh the party  
cloudy 9 Threshed with our Syndicate working  
12 acres fall wheat (Dawson) about 550 Bar  
9 acres Barley about 200 Bar 1 load mixed  
Pear & oats about Bar 1 load Pine Oats  
about Bar H. rather cloudy P.M. slight  
drizzle at times a fine shower after dark  
some distant thunder Joseph Grove brought  
Murray & wife & Henry & wife from  
Indiana for a call P.M. I & Mary went  
to the fair P.M. their Baby is not very well  
Cather was here today & took Frank home  
Henry called awhile P.M.  
10 I helped Lavinia thresh A.M. & B. &  
Milroy P.M. a spread along I took  
Lavinia to the fair this morning the Baby is  
very sick Adeline & Ben Stines wife  
were here to dinner we heard the Baby  
died about 11 A.M. I & Mary went  
down again P.M. Anne is doing pretty well  
A & J & Benji are dressing a goose for  
the Baby this evening W. warm rather  
cloudy through the day a thunder shower  
bunt around south P.M.  
11 I helped J. M. Craig & thresh A.M. &  
Alvah Milroy P.M. I took Chap & their  
h. ganged on Knoll we buried Anne's  
Baby at 4 P.M. (no service) W. very  
fine warm sun but fine breeze
